# **Redhill Academy Trust Parent Survey**

As the Spring Term draws to a close, I am writing to provide some updates and actions on some of the points raised in the recent Redhill Trust Parent Survey.

Thank you to the many of you who took the time to fill in the survey. It was the largest response that we have received and in general, the response was very positive. I would like to thank you for the kind messages of thanks and support for staff. These have been shared and are much appreciated.

## Communication

Some respondents raised communication as an area for improvement. Based on the survey results, we will be reducing our use of text messaging to share information. Instead, we will be making more use of email and the messaging function in the Class Charts app. Therefore, it is very important that we have an up-to-date email address for correspondence. If you wish to update your email contact, please do so using this form. The vast majority of parents and carers are now signed up and are using the Class Charts app. It is also important that you have a **parent** account on Class Charts, as by viewing your child's student account you will not be able to see all the messages shared. We will be sending log in details for Class Charts to parents and carers who have not yet signed up in a separate correspondence.

If you have information that you want to share with the school, please do so using the contact form on the school website, that is linked <u>here</u>. This will ensure that the information is passed on to the correct members of staff.

A copy of the school events calendar can be found on the school website <u>here</u>. This is useful in keeping informed about upcoming events. I encourage you to check this regularly as there are small changes from time to time. We sent out key date letters, giving dates of important events for each year group at the start of the school year. Copies of those letters can be found <u>here</u> for reference. Some respondents suggested that it would be helpful to have more advanced notice of residential trips. A list of planned residential trips can be found <u>here</u>. Please note that this is subject to change.

## **Cover supervisors**

I would like to provide some clarity about the vital role that our team of cover supervisors play in school. We employ a team of cover supervisors who step in to take lessons if the teacher is absent. These are members of staff employed by Hall Park Academy and as such know our students well. This reduces our need to use agency supply staff and we have seen a large reduction in this compared to last year. Our cover supervisor team do a fantastic job of providing continuity in the delivery of high-quality lessons.



# Support for parents

Some parents and carers expressed that they would like more information about how to support their children's study at home. We hold annual revision information events for parents with children in Year 11 and 10.

We also send information to parents and carers about how to support with reading. The reading advice sent earlier this year can be found <u>here</u>.

We will be introducing events for parents with children in other year groups in the coming weeks and months, to complement the work that we do with students in school. Advice about how to support students in exam years can be found in the Year 11 section of the school website, linked <u>here</u>. This is applicable to students in other years, but we will be introducing a study skills section on the website soon.
