Dear Parent/Carer

As the first half term draws to a close, I write to provide you with some updates.

## Attendance

Attendance is an absolute priority at Hall Park Academy. This is because we know that the more that students are present in school, the better their achievement both in terms of academic outcomes and co-curricular experiences. Current whole school attendance stands at 94.53% which is higher than the national average but still below our school target of 96%.

Traditionally, student attendance starts to fall during the next half term. Maintaining attendance at the highest level possible is vital to ensure that everyone achieves their best. To support good attendance, I ask that you please send your child to school every day. NHS guidance states that it is fine to send your child to school with a minor cough or cold. If students are ill during the school day, they should tell a member of staff who will act accordingly.

There are a range of ways that we reward good attendance: students with 100% attendance may wear non-uniform on the first Friday back after the half term break, students with 98% or higher attendance for the full first term will be invited to take part in an attendance reward event on the penultimate day of term, and all students achieving 100% attendance for the year will be invited on the annual free Alton Towers trip. ## STAR

This term we have launched a new initiative with students designed to promote good learning behaviours in lessons. Called STAR, the initiative requires students to:

- Sit up straight, as this benefits student concentration
- Track the speaker, so that students are fully engaged with whoever is speaking
- Ask and answer questions in full sentences
- Respect everyone and their contributions

So far this is going very well and increasing student engagement in lessons. I would be grateful if you would support the initiative by discussing this with your child.

## **Uniform**

As the weather is getting colder, I would like to draw your attention to our [Uniform Policy](#), which can be found on the school website. Please note that students must have a blazer in school every day, which are to be worn at all times. Hoodies and sports coats are not permitted in school. If these are seen being worn, they will be confiscated.

## **Dining spending limits**

## **Co-curricular**
