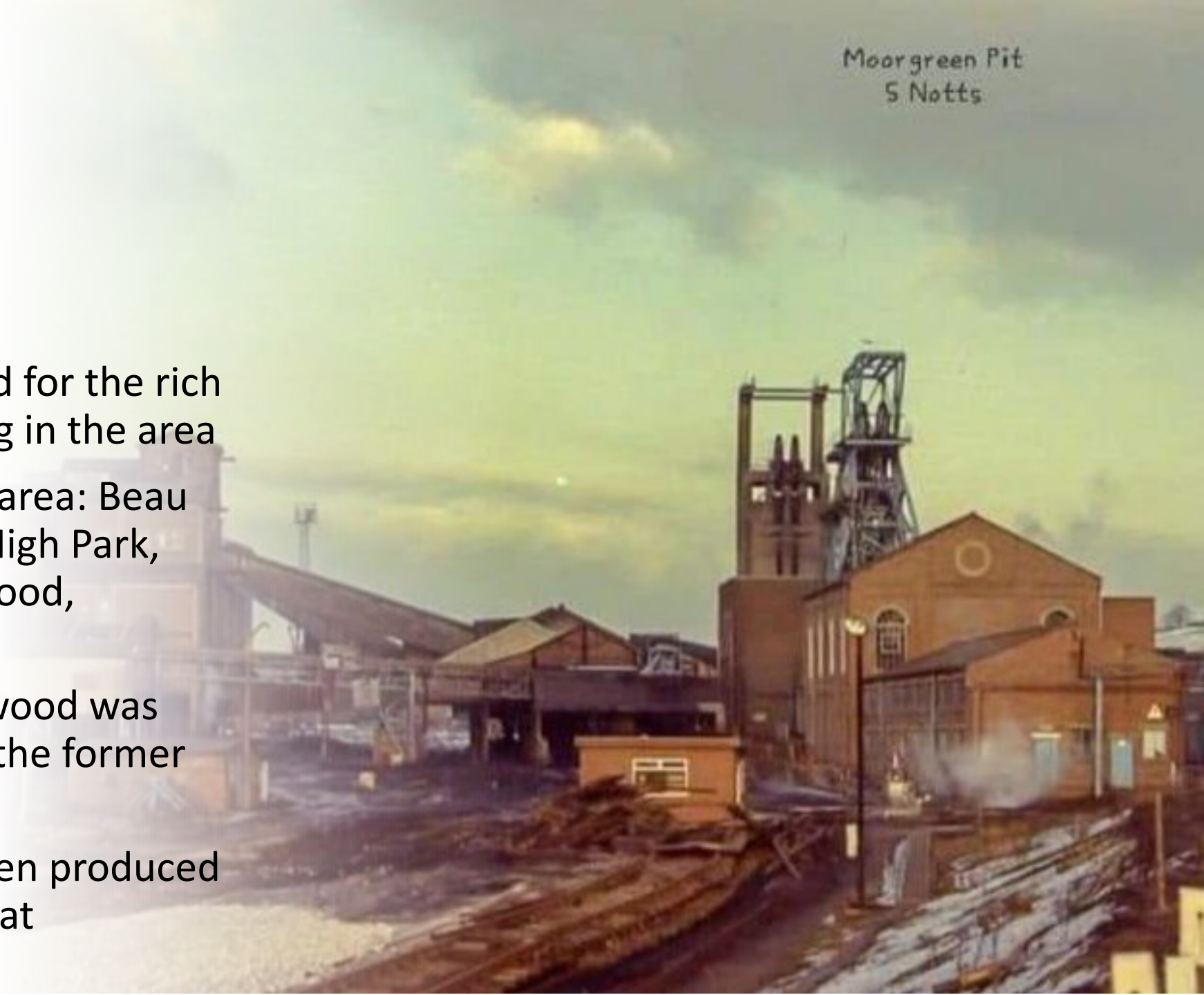
# Astle

- We are named after Jeff Astle.
- England international: played for England in the 1970 World Cup in Mexico.
- Scored the winning goal for West Bromwich Albion in the 1968 FA Cup final.
- 1 of only 9 players to score a goal in every round of the competition in the same season.



# Collier

- Collier House is named for the rich heritage of coal mining in the area
- Many collieries in the area: Beau Vale, Brinsley, Digby, High Park, New London, Underwood, Watnall, Moorgreen
- Colliers Wood in Eastwood was formed on the site of the former Moorgreen Colliery
- 16,000 men and women produced of 900 00 tons of coal at Moorgreen

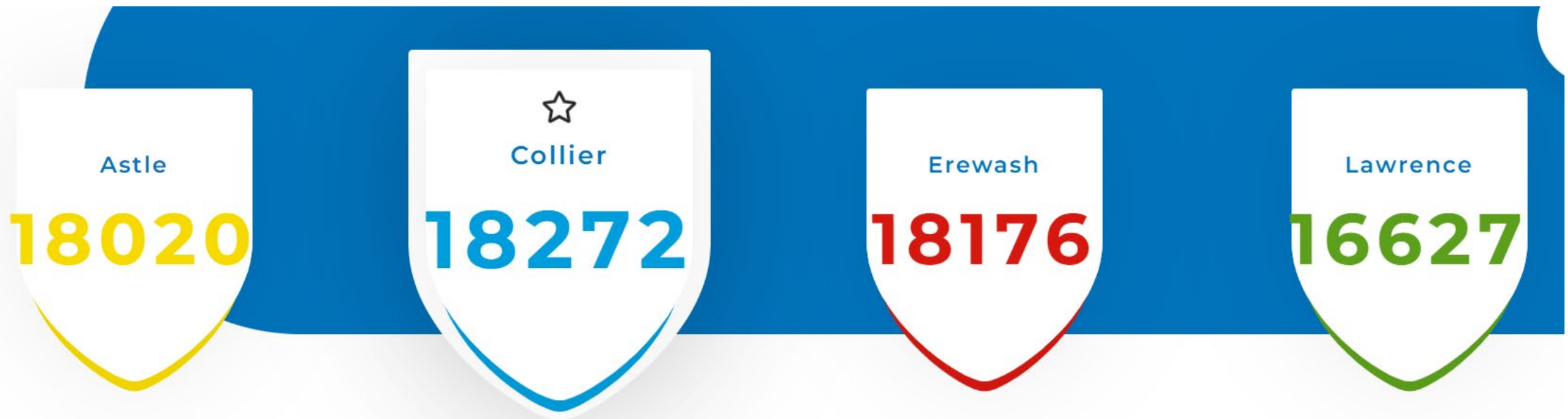
- The River Erewash is a prominent local feature
