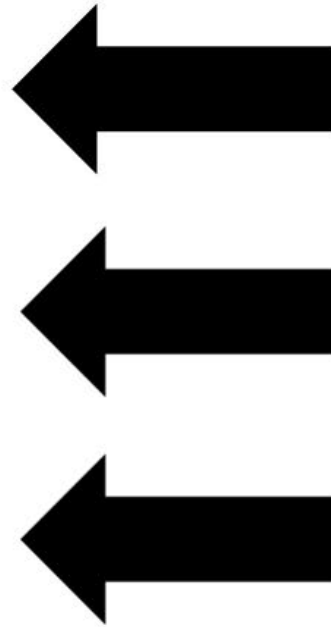


British Values	Hall Park Value	At Hall Park, we believe...

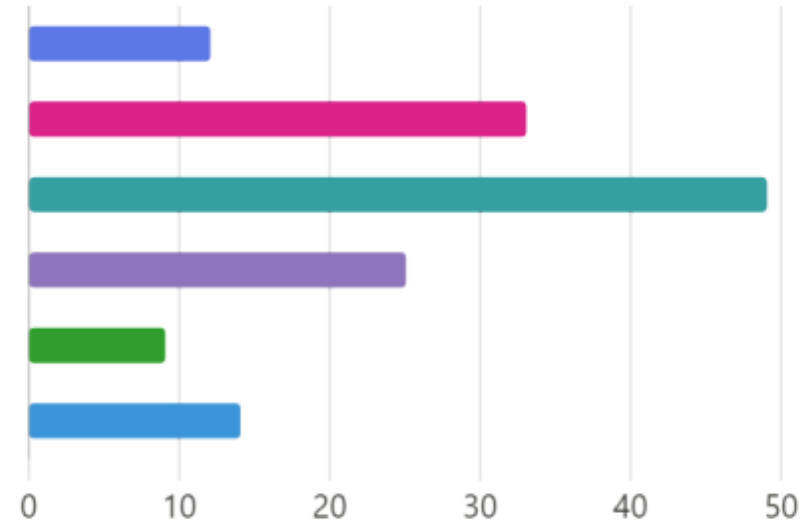

Revision Hours:

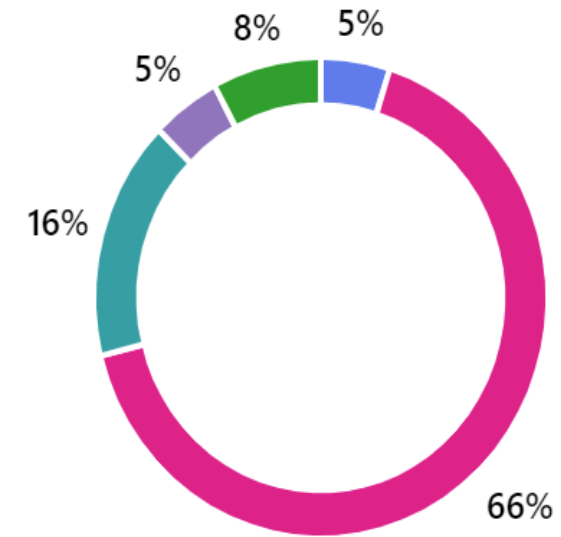
- Most students reported doing 5-9 or 1-4 hour of revision

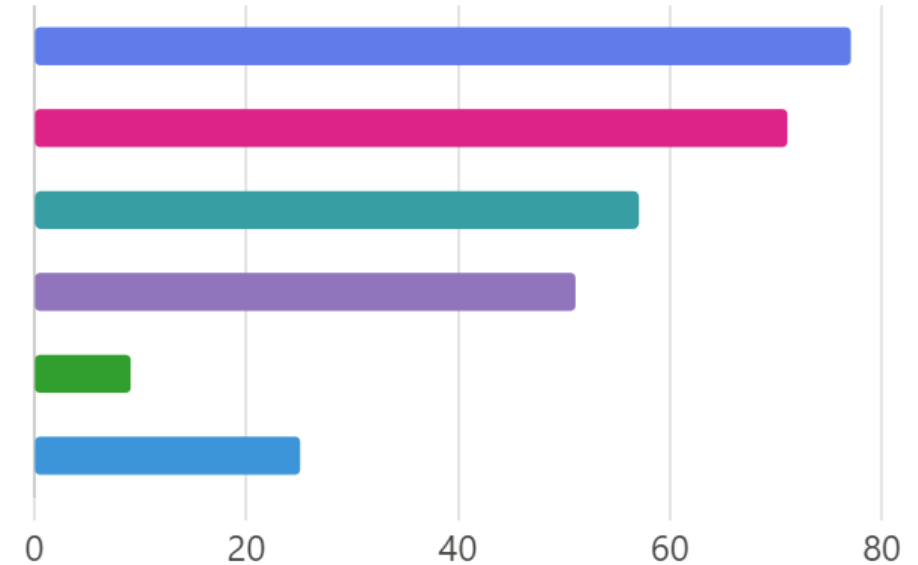
Effectiveness of Revision:

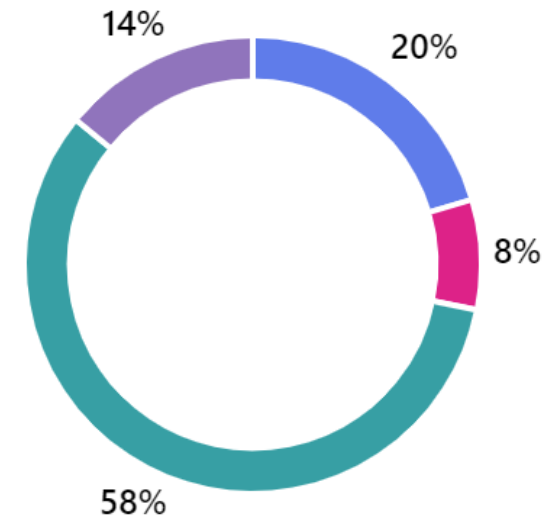
Resources Used:

33 respondents (23%) answered flashcards for this question.



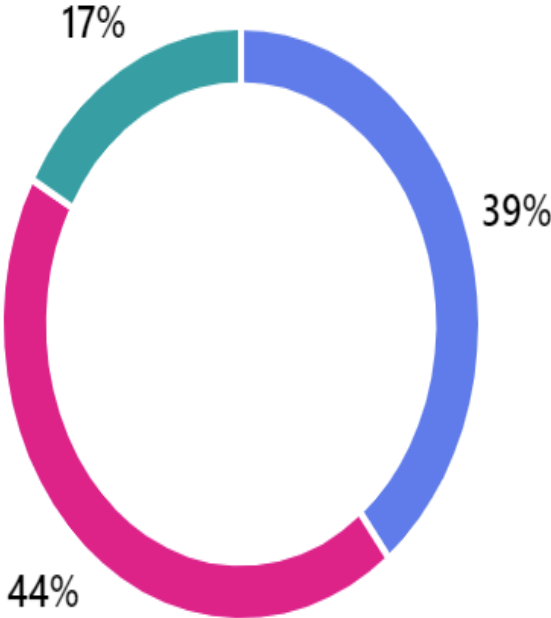
Revision Methods:

- Popular methods were flashcards, mind maps, and reading notes.



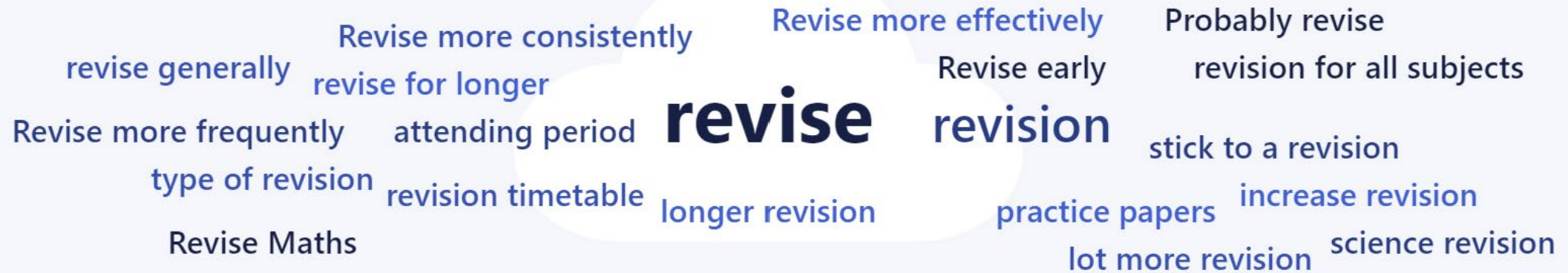
14. Have you achieved the grades that you need to pursue your chosen option?
