## **Class Charts Notifications – Achievement and Behaviour updates**

I am writing to inform you of the procedures in place for communicating key information regarding your child's behaviour and achievements at Hall Park Academy via our Class Charts system.

Class Charts is an online platform used by the Academy to monitor and record student behaviour. As part of our commitment to maintaining strong home-school communication, you will receive notifications through the Class Charts app when there is a notification related to your child. Parents can also view House points received and any other behaviour related points through the app. Should your child receive a detention, you will receive an email in the inbox you have used to sign up to the Class Charts app. This will appear in real time.

House points are awarded based on the characteristics of a Hall Park Learner:

- Hard working
- Ambitious
- Learner
- Leader
- Participant
- Ambassador
- Resilient
- Kind

House points are issued through Class Charts by staff, and students will work towards gaining reward of achievement at a variety of levels. Students will gain badges for earning house points at four tiers – Bronze 200 points, Silver 600 points, Gold 1000 points and Platinum 1500 points. Trophies are allocated at the end of each year for the House with the most house points.

In the event that a student is issued a **class teacher detention**, students will be informed by the member of staff concerned. For all other detentions, students will receive a physical notification slip on the day the detention is set, outlining the details.

If you have not yet registered for Class Charts or are experiencing any difficulties with accessing notifications, please contact the school office and a member of staff will be happy to assist you.
